






































nzl_q5_2. How concerned, if at all, are you generally about each of the following? (Please select one option per row) - The financial cost to the local authority of clearing up flytipping








nzl_q5_3. How concerned, if at all, are you generally about each of the following? (Please select one option per row) - The potential negative impact of litter on housing prices in my area






nzl_q5_4. How concerned, if at all, are you generally about each of the following? (Please select one option per row) - The potential negative impact of litter on my mental well-being






nzl_q5_5. How concerned, if at all, are you generally about each of the following? (Please select one option per row) - The potential harm of litter to animals and wildlife






nzl_q5_6. How concerned, if at all, are you generally about each of the following? (Please select one option per row) - The potential negative impact of litter on tourism in Scotland






nzl_q5_7. How concerned, if at all, are you generally about each of the following? (Please select one option per row) - The possibility that heavily littered areas may encourage crime






nzl_q6_8. How concerned, if at all, are you generally about each of the following? (Please select one option per row) - The possibility of litter causing fires or flooding






nzl_q6_9. How concerned, if at all, are you generally about each of the following? (Please select one option per row) - The possibility of litter causing accidents and harm to people






NZL_q6. How common, if at all, would you say it is for you to see rubbish or litter left in your neighbourhood (i.e. the area in which you live)?


